The Gerald P. Murphy Cancer Foundation is conducting the first systematic study of the oldest-living dogs in North America. Why do it? Because Rottweilers with extreme longevity — equivalent to humans who reach 100 years — may hold the keys to unlocking the mechanisms that connect cancer resistance and successful aging. The research is generating clues that will help people and pets delay or avoid life-threatening diseases, such as cancer.
